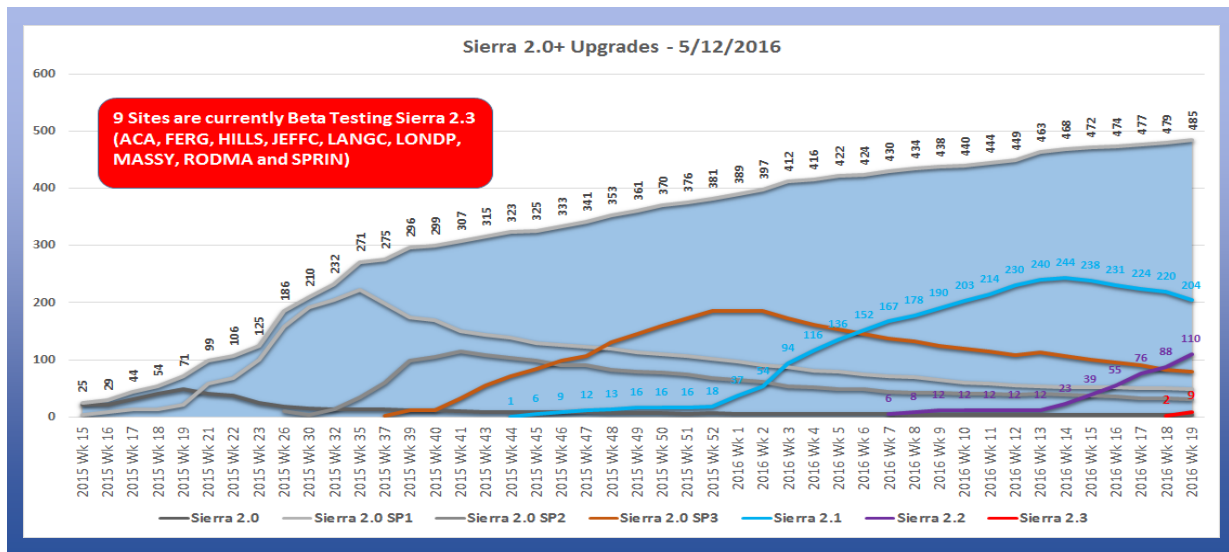
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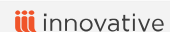


Sierra Release 2.x Live Library Systems

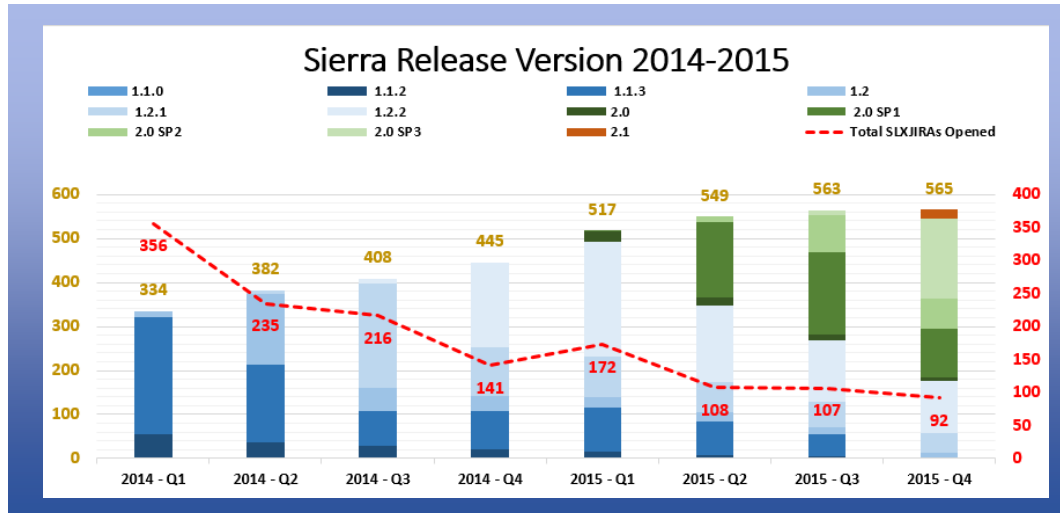


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Sierra 2014 and 2015 Progress Review



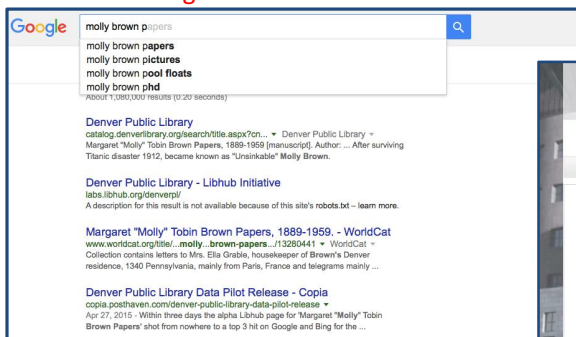

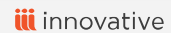
